## FCM Delivers Early Full Duty Release

### Problem

51-year-old Heavy Equipment Operator suffered crush injury to right middle finger resulting in amputation to the first joint. Employee injured his dominant hand, complicated by smoking.



### Solution

FCM quickly coordinated transfer of care in state for amputation surgery. FCM immediately educated on importance of wound care to prevent infection and promote healing as well as compliance with home exercise program six days post operative. The continued focus on therapy compliance and meaningful return to work resulted in early light duty and full duty release.



### Outcome
